from the film "The Starmakers"**

The Steering committee is invited to approve the conditions of use of the whole or extracts from the film the Starmakers

Conditions of use of the whole or extracts from the film "The Starmakers"

CRPP, on behalf of the Association Euratom-CRPP, commissioned the production of the film "The Starmakers" with support of Euratom and holds all legal rights, on behalf of the aforementioned, to the use of the film "The Starmakers". CRPP is bound to protect the rights of Euratom regarding [royalty free license, intellectual property rights] *. Therefore, when the film "The Starmakers" or extracts of it are used in the interests of Euratom, the use shall be royalty free.

The conditions of use of extracts, footage or of the entire movie "The Starmakers " are:

- 1) The sections cut from the movie should deliver their original message. Thus large sections, of the film or documentary, containing the extracts from the film "The Starmakers" should be reviewed by CRPP as a condition of release (with approbation of Digital Studio). Potential user of the movie should define the part of the movie which he would like to insert. Also the CRPP would have a control on how the integration is done, the context and the quality of the pictures environment and comments.
- 2) CRPP, on behalf of the Association Euratom-CRPP, reserve the rights to decide the level of compensation to be charged for incorporation and use of the film "The Starmakers" or extracts of it in third party documentaries.
- 3) Copyrights, film company, producers and film director should be acknowledged.
- 4) The use of extracts, footage or of the entire movie "The Starmakers " shall be governed by a contract or written agreement between the third party and CRPP.
- 5) CRPP shall report regularly on the use of the film "The Starmakers" to the Association Euratom-CRPP Steering Committee.
